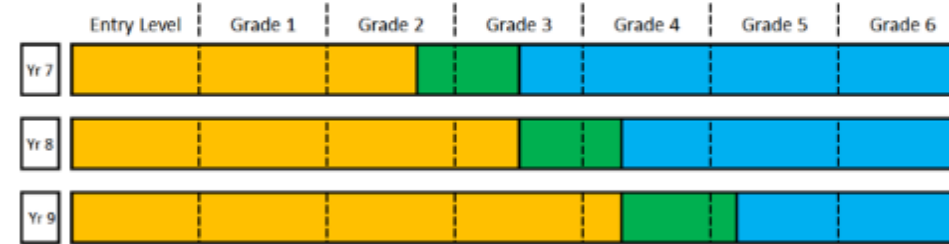

End of Year 11 Target Grade of a...

Grade 6

To achieve a Grade 6 by the End of Year 11 we would typically expect students to be working in the Green 'On Track' sections of the picture below.



- In Year 7, we would expect students to be working between a high Grade 2 and a middle Grade 3.
- In Year 8 between a middle Grade 3 and a low Grade 4
- Year 9 between a low Grade 4 and a low Grade 5.
- Achieving a Grade 6 by the End of Year 11.

This model assumes that students will make a similar amount of progress every year; in practice it is likely to be more varied.

Initial reflections...

I'm making **expected** progress...

Excellent! It's still early days, but you are on course to meet your End of Year 11 target.

I'm **emerging** – what can I do?

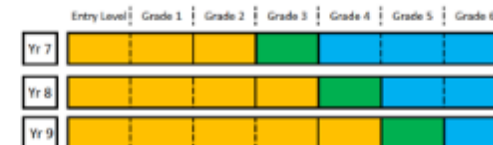
Firstly, don't panic! Your targets won't always be easy to meet in all your subjects. However, it is important you understand what you can do to edge closer to the Green target zone. The reflection weeks that follow your Progress Reports are the perfect time to consider what needs improving and for you to create actions to help you achieve it.

Well done, you are on track to exceed your End of Year 11 target. It would be well worth looking at the target zones for a higher grade (shown below and in more detail on subsequent pages).

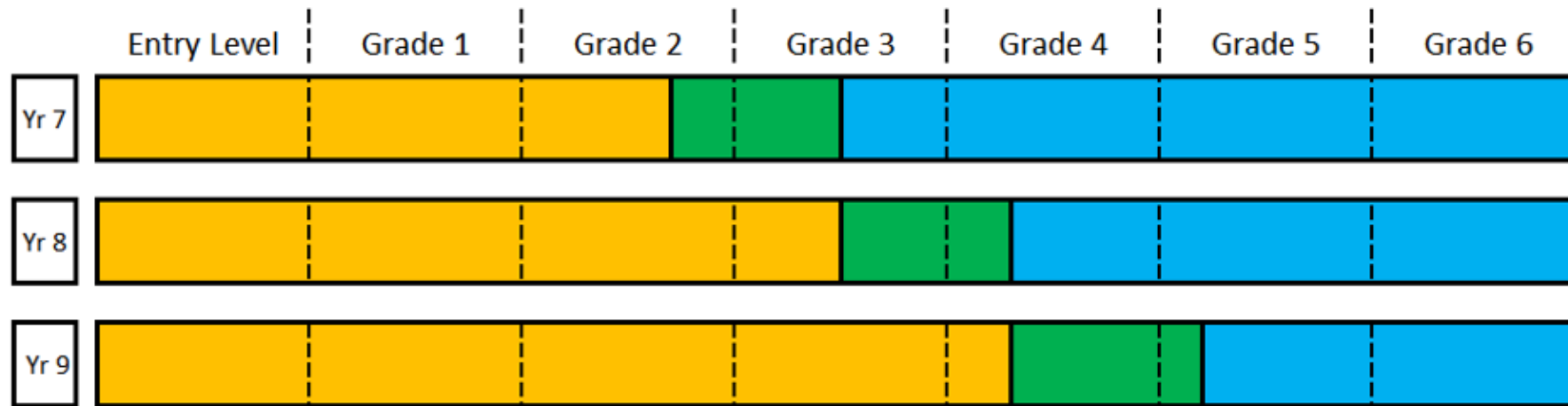
