I will not have a coat peg or cloakroom in secondary school. This is ok.

I will have to carry my coat and bag to all my lessons.

I will need to remember to have all my books, stationery and PE kit with me to take to my lessons.



Some important rules to remember for secondary school:

If I need to contact my parent or carer during the day, I can make a phone call from the school office. I shouldn't bring a mobile phone to school and I am not allowed to use one in lessons, on school trips or at break or lunchtimes.

I need to make sure I have the correct school uniform on at all times. This will include wearing a tie, jumper, having my shirt tucked in and wearing the correct shoes. It's important to look smart!



Lunchtimes are different in secondary school too. This is ok.

In the school canteen, I will have a large variety of food to choose from including hot and cold options.



I can choose where I sit to eat my lunch: in the hall, outside or with my friends.



If I want to play football on the Astro at lunchtime I must eat my food first as no food is allowed on the Astro. I must also bring trainers to wear to play football on the Astro.

I might have some more questions I want to ask about secondary School. This is ok.



I can always ask an adult at home or an older sibling.

I am looking forward to starting my new journey in my new school. I will learn new things and make new friends.

My Day at Secondary School

I will arrive at school by 8.40am and go straight to my tutor room.

I might walk to school or arrive by bus. My parent might drive me to school.

In my tutor room, my tutor will register me and share any messages with us. Some days we will go to our Year Group assembly in the main hall.

I will go to lesson 1 on my timetable for that day. Then I will go to lesson 2.

Then it is breaktime. I can buy something from the canteen or I can bring a healthy snack into school from home.

I might want to stay and eat my food in the hall, go outside or go to M1 to be with friends during breaktime.



A bell sounds at 10.55am to remind me it is time to go to my next lesson.

I will go to lesson 3 and lesson 4 on my timetable.

Then it is lunchtime. I can buy something from the canteen or bring in a healthy packed lunch. I won't bring any fizzy drinks and I will make sure that all my litter goes in the bin when I have finished.

After I have eaten my lunch I might go to a club. Wallingford School has sports clubs, chess club, Warhammer club and lots of other clubs at lunchtimes.

I might go to the library or the Astro to play football with my friends (remembering to bring trainers if I want to go on the Astro as school shoes are not allowed).



At 1.20pm a bell sounds to remind me that it's time to go to lesson 5.

After lesson 5 I will go to lesson 6.

At 3.05pm the teacher will dismiss my class and it is time to go home or go to a sports club.

If I am getting a bus then I will go to the bus bay where teachers will help me if I am not sure which bus to get on.

If I am walking home then I can go straight home.

If my parent is picking me up, I will arrange a meeting point with them away from the bus bay so they can park and I can find them easily.

I might have some worries. I can speak with an adult or an older sibling about these.

If I lose something then I can go to the main office and the adults in there will help me.

If I feel unwell then I can let my teacher know. They might encourage me to stay in class a little longer to see if I start to feel better or they will ask me to go to the Senior First Aider who can help me.



If I am worried about something I can tell any adult in school and they will help me. I can also tell an adult at home and they can help me too.
